




Wing Commander Agnihotri's insights provided a valuable glimpse into the intricacies of her journey, offering a comprehensive view of the aviation industry and its demands.





His insights shed light on the complex interplay of various elements that impact women's professional journeys, highlighting the importance of addressing and dismantling not just external barriers but also those that may be self-imposed or societal in nature. This nuanced perspective provided valuable context to the discussion on gender diversity and the challenges women face in the workforce.
